TOP 5 TIPS TO SAVE WATER INDOORS

Be leak free - check for running overflows and fix any dripping taps.

Don't leave the tap running while brushing your teeth – you could save over 7,000 litres of water per year.

Dishwashers & Washing Machines – only run these when they are full. A washing machine on full cycle uses up to 65 litres of water and dish-washers 20 litres.

Reduce the time you spend in the shower – a regular shower uses about 35 litres of water in 5 minutes. Beware! A power shower uses approximately 125 litres in same time.

Only flush when necessary! - the average toilet uses 9 to 14 litres per flush (e.g. there is no need to flush when you just throw a tissue in the bowl).



TOP 5 TIPS TO SAVE WATER OUTDOORS



Collect rainwater – rainwater is excellent for your garden. Collect it in a water butt fed from your gutters.

Watering cans – if you must water your plants, do it in the early morning or evening when it is cooler. Forget the hose and always use a watering can fitted with a rose.

Grass - Grass can survive for long periods without water and will quickly recover when the next rain showers arrive.

Washing your car – a hose uses more water in one hour than the average family uses in a day. Use a bucket of water, not a hose, to wash your car or clean windows.

Don't hose driveways, paths & patios – just use a brush instead.

Again we ask that you pick up after your dog, the dog warden has been in the area and has started to issue fines.

Failure to clean up your dog's waste can lead to a €150 "on-the-spot" fine or on summary conviction to a fine of up to €3,000.

Dog waste bags can be purchased in the Vet's or the Service Station in Foxrock Village.
