Aoife is now 18 and her immune system failed over five years ago. Since then she has been battling multiple debilitating illnesses and her health is deteriorating by the day. Aoife can no longer attend school although her dream is to sit her Leaving Certificate. Her only hope is to travel to Germany for stem cell treatment in July and this follows extensive immune therapy in the USA for six weeks at the end of 2017. Three generations are involved in Aoife's journey: her grand-mother will be known to many as she has worked tirelessly on behalf of Foxrock Tidy Towns over the years,

looking after the village in particular and Aoife's mother Linda has also been heavily involved in Foxrock in recent years with her work with Colm Doyle of Doyle Landscapes.

The financial resources of the Kenny family have been seriously strained over the years with visits to multiple specialists, exhaustive tests etc. To support them and to help Aoife on her journey, a fundraising dinner will be held in Foxrock Golf Club on Thursday 8th March at 7.30pm - €35 per person. There will be a raffle on the night and we appreciate the support of businesses in the village who have donated prizes.

First Love is possibly Samuel Beckett's funniest short story. It tells the tale of a man who falls in love in peculiar circumstances - having been turned out of his own home. John Banville felt it is "the most nearly perfect short story ever written."

First Love is performed by Marcus Lamb who recently played Bob Cratchit in the feature film *The Man who Invented Christmas* and Dr. James Oakley in RTÉ's *Fair City*. Marcus also enthralled the audience with his performance in *The End*, last year's Beckett in Foxrock production.

Beckett in Foxrock 2018 - *First Love* is the third annual celebration of the Nobel Laureate's close connection with Foxrock. Samuel Beckett was born and

brought up in Brighton Road, just yards from Tullow Church which he attended in the company of his mother. The Foxrock area and many of its residents feature in much of his work.
