

# Foxrock Golf Club, Golf Lane, Torquay Road on Monday 11th November at 7.30pm

The Harcourt Street Line, which ran from Dublin City Centre to Bray, was the catalyst for the development of Foxrock. The line opened in 1854, Foxrock station in 1861, and by 1862 sites for 'mansions and pretty villas' were being advertised in the *Irish Times*. Foxrock station was regarded as one of the most important on the line which ran through what is now the village car park. This is a repeat of the talk given in August by Cathy Scuffil, Dublin City Council's Historian in Residence. Thanks to public demand, Cathy will repeat her talk for anyone who missed it. This talk is to complement the permanent photographic exhibition which is in Foxrock Village car park.

# **Leaf Mould Cages**



The installation of leaf mould cages by Foxrock Tidy Towns, the first of the four CCAP projects (see above), has already been completed on The Thicket, Joyce Avenue and the village car park. The cages have a base underneath to ensure that nothing can grow/get into them and only fallen leaves are put in which must be very wet.

They are sealed with lids and, as the cages only contain leaves with no nutrients, they do not attract rodents etc. It takes approximately two years for the leaves to compost on their own to produce a lovely weed-free mulch. Sincere thanks to residents who have supported the installation of these cages.





# AGE-FRIENDLY BUSINESS ACCREDITATION

FACE is delighted to announce that the majority of businesses in the village have successfully achieved 'Age-Friendly Business Accreditation'. This follows a process which involved participating in a workshop, developing four special actions to ensure their business is welcoming to older people, and completing these steps which are reviewed by a 'secret shopper'.

The businesses will receive their certificates at a special presentation in The Gables on 25th November by An Cathaoirleach, Cllr. Jim O'Leary and the Chief Executive of Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council, Frank Curran. Thanks to the exceptional contribution by

these businesses to achieve their individual accreditation, FACE has applied for Foxrock village to be acknowledged as the first 'Age-Friendly' village in the county – this status is pending.


The approved businesses include Brighton Road Bistro, Cassini Boutique, Fagan Motors, Grumps, Hunters Estate Agent, Kerb, Pure Pharmacy, Sherry Fitzgerald, Texaco-Centra, The Gables, The Scarlet Heifer, Thomas's of Foxrock, and Toner Solicitors.

The project was supported by the installation by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council of two Age-Friendly car spaces for older people who wish to park



outside shops in the village rather than the car park. Whilst there is no enforcement in relation to these spaces, it is appreciated that residents are leaving them free for use by those who benefit from this accessibility to the village retailers.

Hopefully, everyone has viewed the sixteen panels illustrating the history of the Harcourt Street Line and Foxrock Station which were installed in the village car park in August.


This heritage project was

The project was supported with funding from Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council and Leopardstown Racecourse.






